**Annual Ski Day sign-up** for Feb. 8 at Canaan Valley was sent home last week with all children in grades 1-8. **All 5<sup>th</sup> -8<sup>th</sup> grade students are encouraged to attend. No student will be left behind because of finances.** Students in 1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> grade are welcome to attend with an adult chaperone. For those students who are not planning to participate, alternate activities will be planned at school. This is considered a school day and attendance will be taken. We will have a 12 p.m. dismissal. Skiers will return in the evening.

**Intent for Re-Enrollment form** for the 2024-2025 school year will need to be submitted by **February 29**. The paper-work will go home next Friday. It will also need to be accompanied by a \$35/child or \$75/family minimum deposit which will be applied toward the \$300/child early registration fee with the balance due by June 15, 2024. This early deposit will lock families into the \$300 registration fee rate until June 15<sup>th</sup>. All families that register between March 2<sup>nd</sup> and July 1<sup>st</sup> will pay a \$350 registration fee. Families that register after July 1<sup>st</sup> will be charged a \$380 registration fee.
