Dear Parents:

Today we kicked off our booster club campaign with the students. Your child has probably already told you about some of the prizes that he/she would like to win. It is my hope that some of the students' enthusiasm for this fundraising project will rub off on you!

Remember, this fundraising project is one of two that will seriously impact our school program financially. In fact a large part of the funds your child raises will go directly to help your child's classroom. It is our goal that each student sell at least 10 cards. Each card sells for \$10.00. Some of the discounts on the card will pay for the card in just one visit, but remember the card can be used for the whole year. The thing I like most about this fundraising project is that we get to keep most of the sales as profit (about 10% goes towards prizes) and it gets the name of our school out into the community while helping our school.
